Dear Pathways Families,

Local media has released some confusing or conflicting messaging regarding COVID-19 and its impact on schools in the coming months. I would like to clarify some points and provide you with contact information should you have any questions or concerns.

The Governor has announced that schools will remain closed for the remainder of the 2019/2020 academic year. However, that does not mean that instruction or student progression has been interrupted. As a model distance learning school, Pathways In Education was uniquely positioned to respond to this crisis. Pathways' teachers and students have continued to work hard each day and make progress on their coursework from home. Students should complete at least two units per week, regularly communicate via email or phone with their teachers, and attend all scheduled virtual class meetings.

Please note that in order to receive credit, students must complete all coursework and tests. If you have transitioned to an alternate distance learning course format, you must begin where you left off. Incomplete courses will not receive credit and will not be eligible for transfer.

“Non-contact” drop-off and pick-up is generally available at each campus for materials, textbooks, and technology, but please coordinate with your teacher ahead of time.
