Greetings Pathways Families!

We hope you are well. We truly miss seeing the students in person during this time, but we are thankful we can remain open, communicate with families, and continue to help students work towards their goals.

Our teachers will be out of office April 6 - 10. However, with the recent transition to distance learning and social distancing, we are seeing this week as an opportunity for students to continue to progress in their work. During this time, please work with your child and support them as you have in the past, providing a quiet space to work on homework, and asking students about their learning to check progress and understanding.

This week, teachers are meeting with their students to devise a plan for the work that is expected to be done when teachers resume appointments on April 13th.

Students are still expected to log in and complete work on a daily basis. We are currently in LP9 and at this point of the learning period, students should have completed at least 3 units. Students are still expected to have 5 units completed by the end of the learning period on April 21.

If students complete a SAW unit and are ready to test, they will be able to test on April 13th.

Once teachers return on April 13th, we will continue with distance learning as per the governor's direction until at least April 30th. We will continue to monitor the situation and will return to regular school operation once we are given the approval by local and state authorities.
